



No-Cost Testing Kit Order by Governor Scott VEHI Decision Pending

VEHI has received calls and e-mails about the December 7th decision by the governor to require private insurance companies to cover at-home, COVID-19 testing kits at no cost. This action covers a limited number of tests per covered life, per month, as well as specific brands of tests. There is much more about it we are now trying to learn.

VEHI is a self-insured entity and has the option (at this point) to elect in or out of the at-home testing order at 100% reimbursement. We are working with BCBSVT and others to understand the details of the governor's decision, its cost and administrative implications, and its relationship to surveillance testing and test-to-stay programs in schools.

After conducting further research, we will decide if VEHI will voluntarily participate in this effort and will communicate with you immediately. Thank you for your patience.
