



DataPath Revised Agreement – Important Update!

Districts engaging DataPath to take over administration of HRAs, FSAs and/or HSAs on May 1, 2018 have until March 28th to execute their DataPath Agreement. Copies of the Service Agreement BAA and BCBSVT Confidentiality Agreement have been sent to each district currently working with Future Planning Associates.

In place of sending an amendment, DataPath will be sending a **revised Service Agreement BAA that will need to be signed by March 28th**. This agreement includes more favorable language recommended by VSBIT in sections 2.5, 3.3, 3.5. In addition, it corrects the state of Texas to Vermont in section 2.4(a).

Lastly, there has been questions surrounding the **confidentially agreement for the BCBSVT Claims file feed**, which was provided by Ben Robbins. In the first paragraph, it mentions that DataPath is a business in Massachusetts which was an oversight as DataPath is located in Arkansas. This has been corrected and **will be resent** along with the revised Service Agreement BAA.

These two updated documents must be signed and returned to DataPath by March 28, 2018 by districts that wish DataPath to take over the FPA administration services. If you have any questions, please contact Ben Robbins at brobbins@datapathadmin.com or at 501-355-0202.

Don't forget to formally notify Future Planning Associates of: your intent to terminate their services as of April 30, 2018, your engagement of DataPath, and your expectation of an accounting of all funds the district provided FPA during the contract term of January 1, 2018 – April 30, 2018 and inquire as to when the final settlement process will be completed.

Districts that do not elect to engage DataPath by March 28th will need to make other arrangements for administration of health care spending accounts effective no later than June 1, 2018.
