



Creditable Coverage and Medicare Part D

VEHI would like to take this opportunity to remind you that the federal Open Enrollment for Medicare Part D Prescription Coverage is from October 15 through December 7, 2020. For your information, individuals may enroll in a Medicare drug plan when they first become eligible for Medicare and each year thereafter during open enrollment (October 15th to December 7th). Eligible individuals may delay enrollment in part D without penalty as long as they are enrolled in other creditable coverage.

All VEHI Plans are Creditable

All VEHI employers are required to send a notice of creditable coverage prior to October 15th, to those covered by their plans who are age 65 or older. Many employers provide the notice to ALL employees to ensure no one is missed.
