Age 26 Coverage Termination Notices to Adult Dependents to Resume

Governor Scott issued a stay-at-home order that became effective March 25, 2020. That order required BCBSVT to close their physical building, which, in turn, led them to suspend sending termination notices for adult dependents turning age 26 in April and May of 2020. This extended temporarily the benefit coverage of these dependents.

BCBSVT's physical building still remains closed, but the carrier has resumed sending termination notices for dependents turning age 26. *This means adult dependents who turn(ed) 26 in the months of **April, May or June** will be terminated from their subscriber's plan effective June 30, 2020.*

Termination notices will be sent to all affected dependents in the coming week.

These dependents have the option of enrolling in COBRA (please send them updated COBRA notification immediately), in benefit coverage provided by an employer if offered, or in public or private benefit programs through [Vermont Health Connect](#).
